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PHYSICAL TRAINING AND SPORT DEVELOPMENT DIRECTIONS IN AZERBAIJAN IN 2013–2014

У статті аналізуються основні напрями соціальної політики в галузі фізичної культури і спорту в Азербайджанській Республіці, також розглядається участь збірних команд країни в республіканських, міжнародних змаганнях та турнірах за кордоном у 2013–2014 рр. Надано інформацію про медалі, завойовані в олімпійських і неолімпійських видах спорту на офіційних міжнародних змаганнях, про чемпіонати світу, Європи, за Кубок світу. У статті також висвітлено питання, що стосуються роботи ООН, Європейської Ради, країн СНД та інших міжнародних організацій і державних органів, що займаються молоддю і політикою спорту різних країн із метою розширення і розвитку міжнародних відносин у галузі спорту.

State care given to the physical culture and sport in Azerbaijan Republic is widely described in the given article. The participation of our national team at republican, international contests of our country and at the tournaments of foreign countries during 2013–2014 years is also analysed in this article. The information about the medals gained in Olympic and non-Olympic sports at official international contests, about World, European, World Cup championships is given in this article. The issues concerning the work of UNO, European Council, CIS countries and other international organizations and public authorities engaged in youth and sport policy of the different countries for the expansion and development of international relationship with the youth and in the field of sport are also stated in the given article.

В статье анализируются основные направления социальной политики в области физической культуры и спорта в Азербайджанской Республике, также рассматривается участие сборных команд страны в республиканских, международных соревнованиях и турнирах за границей в 2013–2014 гг. Предоставлена информация о медалях, завоеванных в олимпийских и в неолимпийских видах спорта на официальных международных соревнованиях, о чемпионатах мира, Европы, за Кубок мира. В статье также освещены вопросы, относящиеся к работе ООН, Европейского Совета, стран СНГ, других международных организаций и государственных органов, занимающихся молодежью и политикой спорта различных стран для расширения и развития международных отношений в области спорта.

Formulation of the problem. The base of sport policy of independent Azerbaijan government was founded by national leader Heydar Aliyev in 1993 and the achievements gained in this sphere were continued from year to year. Just starting from this period the activities on state level for the development of sport and Olympic Movement started to be implemented and in 1997 after the first half-year sport and Olympic Movement development in the country by quality has been raised

to a new stage due to National Olympic Committee. In 1997 by the election of Ilham Aliyev as a President of National Olympic Committee Sport and Olympic Movement in Azerbaijan stepped to renaissance epoch [5].

298 republican contests have been organized in our country in 2013 (150 contests in 2012) and there was held 57 international contests (35 contests in 2012). The participation of national team of our country was provided in 281 international tournaments held



in foreign countries (250 contests in 2012). 280 gold, 233 silver and 269 bronze, but in general 782 medals (735 medals in 2012, including 255 gold, 244 silver and 236 bronze) were gained in Olympic and non-Olympic official international contests on kinds of sport, World, European championships and Cup tournaments. 296 medals of them (101 gold, 74 silver, 121 bronze) won on Olympic, but 486 medals (179 gold, 159 silver, 148 bronze) won on non-Olympic kinds of sport. As information we can say that during 2003–2013 years in general 5 398 medals (1 918 gold, 1 533 silver, 1 947 bronze) have been gained. Last year each national team on sports participated in 154 training-practice sessions not less than 12 days (83 sessions in 2012). 103 of these training-practice sessions were held in Azerbaijan and 51 of them in foreign countries. In general, 6 000 sportsmen took part at training-practice sessions [5].

In 2013 in honor of 90th jubilee of our leader Heydar Aliyev a number of international tournaments were held on different kinds of sport. Thus with the participation of the representatives of 24 countries cycle race “Tour de Azerbaijan”, stage contest on judo of “Big Helmet” series, international chess festival and international tournament in wrestling “Nakhchivan Open–2013” in Nakhchivan have been taken place. Moreover, international tournaments in water polo, swimming and basketball held in Mingechevir, as well as “President’s Regatta” rowing have been held in honor of great leader’s jubilee. Universal fighting “Heydar Aliyev Cup” organized in Gusar, hapki do “Heydar Aliyev Cup” held in Masalli and international tournament on boxing among the teenagers were also devoted to our leader’s jubilee. Unforgettable international tournaments on kickboxing held by assistance of Azerbaijan Embassies in Southern African Republic and Austria were also devoted to Heydar Aliyev’s memory.

XXVII World Summer Student Games is one of the important contests of the year 2013. In XXVII World Summer Student Games held on 6–17 July by International University Sport Federation in the capital of Tatarstan Republic of Russian Federation our country achieved historical success. Azerbaijan was represented by 78 of its sportsmen. The contests were held on 27 kinds of sport and student-sportsmen of our republic participated in 12 kinds of sport (chess, athletics, weightlifting, judo, boxing, sambo, belt wrestling, sport gymnastics, fencing, free– style wrestling (men), free-style wrestling (women) and Greco-Roman wrestling). Our team winning 16 medals (4 gold, 5 silver, 7 bronze) in 8 kinds of sport among 162 countries according total team reckoning

was honored with 15th place. We would like to remind that in 2011 at XXVI World Summer Student Games held in Shenjen of China Peoples Republic our republic was represented by 22 sportsmen in 6 kinds of sport. Winning 2 silver medals we got 46th place among 167 countries. We must mention that in XXVI World Summer Student Games among Islam governments the population of which is several times more than ours Azerbaijan won the 1st place, among CIS countries the 4th place, among the European countries the 9th place. Turkey with 2 gold medals took 29th place, Iran with 1 gold medal 33th place, Armenia with 1 gold medal 32th place, Georgia with 1 silver medal and 2 bronze medals 48th place. In general, only 62 countries were able to win the medals in World Student Games [1].

In 2013 on 22 September – 1 October in Palembang of Indonesia there was held III Islam Solidarity Games in 13 kinds of sport. 1 586 sportsmen of 46 countries and 3 continents were represented at these games. Azerbaijan team was represented with 53 sportsmen in 9 kinds of sport and in 7 kinds (karate, swimming, athletics, bow shooting, weight lifting, taekwondo and ushu), winning 24 medals (6 gold, 9 silver, 9 bronze) took the 7th place. In team contests won a gold medal in karate, silver medal in bow shooting. At the same time, gold medal (200 m) won for the first time in swimming contest and silver medal won in bow shooting in team count was the first success in these kinds of independence period.

Let’s mention that in 2005, in I Islam Solidarity Games held in 4 cities (Mecca, Medina, Taif, Gidde) of Saudis Arabian Kingdom 55 countries in 14 kinds of sport were fighting. Azerbaijan team was represented in these games by 103 sportsmen in 12 kinds and getting a good result in 5 kinds (karate, weightlifting, basketball, fencing, taekwondo) won 15 medals (4 gold, 4 silver, 7 bronze) and took the 8th place [6].

In World Championship on judo held on 26–31 August in Rio-de-Janeiro of Brazil Elkhan Mammadov (100 kg) won the world champion’s title. In World Championship on rowing held on 30 August – 3 September in Duysburgh of Germany Azerbaijan canoeist Valentin Demyanenko in march to 200 m distance showed the result of 38 462 seconds and for the fourth time became a World champion. In World Championship on boxing among the men held on 11–27 October in Almaty city of Kazakhstan Mahammadrasul Majidov (+91kg) and Javid Chalabiyev (56 kg) were honored with a title of World champion. In European Championship on chess held on 8–17 November in Warsaw, the capital of Po-



land our national male team became 2 times European champions. In “Grand Prix–2013” contest on motor boating (Formula–2) held on 6–7 July in Seaside National Park along with Azerbaijan sportsmen, the sportsmen of Sweden, Austria, Great Britain, Latvia, Germany, Southern African Republic, Italy, Russia and Hungary fought for the prize. But it was pilot of Swedish team “Getel Racing” Erik Stark who became the winner of the tournament. The second place was occupied by Yonas Anderson, a member of “Azerbaijan” team and the third place was occupied by Ulvis Slakteris, pilot of “Riga powerboat” collective of Latvia [7].

In 2014 more than 300 republican contests (298 contests in 2013) were organized together with the operating federations in our republic, and held 55 international contests (57 contests in 2013). But in 320 international contests held in foreign countries (281 contests in 2013) our national team took participation.

In 2014 during Olympic and non-Olympic official international contests on kinds of sport, World and European championships and Cup tournaments 275 gold, 255 silver and 275 bronze, in total 805 medals (782 medals in 2013, including 280 gold, 233 silver, 269 bronze) have been gained.

Each national team participated in 160 training-practice sessions not less than 12 days (154 sessions in 2013). 115 of these training-practice sessions were held in Azerbaijan and 45 of them in foreign countries. In general, 6 500 sportsmen took part at training-practice sessions.

During 2005–2015 years the references related to the implementation of “State Program for the development of football in Azerbaijan Republic” have been prepared and studied.

According to the decree № 654 of the President of Azerbaijan Republic dated 4 March, 2005 about establishment of “Physical training and sport Day” every year the 5th of March is celebrated as “Physical training and sport Day”. And in connection with it this year a series of events were carried out in Baku and in all towns and regions of our republic.

The documents presented in accordance with the assignment of the coaching teachers for high, I and II professional qualification in sports have been considered according existing Unified Sport Classification of Azerbaijan Republic. In 2014, 98 coaching teachers on different sports were given the professional category including high professional category to 3, I category to 83 and II category to 12 coaches.

44 persons were honored with a title of “Honorable Physical Training and Sport Work-

er of Azerbaijan Republic”, 85 with a title of “Honored Coach of Azerbaijan Republic”, 7 with a title “Honored Master of Sport of Azerbaijan Republic”, 32 with a title “Republican referee”. 127 persons have carried out the norms of “Master of Sport”.

National Strategy project on the development of physical training and sport in Azerbaijan Republic in the period of 2014–2020 years was prepared in accordance with 7.5 section of Development Conception of “Azerbaijan 2020: future vision” approved by the decree of the President of Azerbaijan Republic dated 29th of December 2012.

In accordance with the planned schedule approved by Youth and Sport Ministry of Azerbaijan Republic in 2014 Republican Council of “Ganjlik” Student-Sport Society among the students of high schools has held Republican championships on judo (men), free-style, Greco-Roman wrestling, basketball (men, women), handball (men, women), chess (men, women), table tennis (men, women), draughts (men, women), volleyball (men, women), badminton (men, women), athletics (men, women), swimming (men, women).

55 international contests, including World and European Championships were organized in our country in 2014. Thus, the events like 77th Congress of World Sport Press Association (WSPA) with the participation of representatives of more than 100 countries which is of great importance for Azerbaijan in international arena from propaganda’s point of view; European Classification Tournament on athletics like license to II Olympic Summer Games’ of Youth with the participation about 700 sportsmen from 38 countries; 30th European championship on rhythmic gymnastics with the participation of more than 500 gymnasts and official representative personnel from 33 countries; European championship and World championship among teenagers and other event have been organized and held in a high level in Baku. Moreover, our country hosted scientific-practical conferences, regional Cup contests, including next General Assembly of Olympic Committee. International Sport Films Festival was held in Baku together with Culture and Tourism Ministry of Azerbaijan Republic [4].

In 2014 in honor of 91st jubilee of our leader Heydar Aliyev a number of international tournaments on different sports including cycle race “Tour de Azerbaijan” with the participation of the representatives of 24 countries, stage contest on judo of “Big Helmet” series, international chess festival and international tournament in wrestling “Nakhchivan Open–2013” in Nakhchivan, international tournaments in water polo, swimming and basketball



held in Mingechevir and rowing “President’s Regatta”, universal fighting “Heydar Aliyev Cup” in Gusar, international tournament on boxing among the teenagers have been held.

II Olympic Games of Teenagers was held on 14–28 July 2014, in the town Nanjing of China Peoples Republic. 3888 sportsmen from 204 countries took part at the contests held on 29 sports.

In these games on 9 sports Azerbaijan was represented by 21 sportsmen.

In result, Azerbaijan winning 5 gold, 6 silver and 1 bronze medals among 204 participating countries and took the 10th place among won countries, and according to the quantity of medals (12 medals) occupied the 14th place. Our team was on the 6th place among European countries, 3rd place among CIS countries and 1st place among Islamic countries [5].

In World Championship on free-style wrestling held on 08–14 September 2014 in Dashkend the capital of Kazakhstan Haji Aliyev showing high result won the world champion’s title.

In European Championship on taekwondo held on May 01–04, 2014 in Baku Radik Isayev won the gold medal.

In European Championship on wrestling among men held on April 01–08, 2014 in the town Vantaa of Finland Mariya Stadnik, Haji Aliyev and Ruslan Dibirgadjiyev won European champions’ titles.

In European Championship on chess among clubs held on September 13–21, 2014 in Bilbao town of Spain, Azerbaijan team “SOCAR Azerbaijan” consisting of male sportsmen for the second time won the title of champion.

In European Championship on boxing held on June 01–08, 2014 in Bucharest, the capital of Romania Yelena Vistropova won the gold medal.

“Garabakh” football club of UEFA league performing successfully in group stage for the first time gathered 6 points among Azerbaijan clubs.

I European Games will be held on 12–28 July of 2015 and World Cup contests on chess will be held on September 10 – October 04 in Baku.

In 2016 World Chess Olympiad, in 2017 IV Islamic Solidarity Games, in 2020 Qualifying Games of European Championship on football and other events are supposed to be carried out.

On January 03–05, 2014 national team on volleyball consisting of female sportsmen participated at classification stage of World championship held in Baku. Our team met with the teams of Serbia, Israel, Estonia and becoming the first in the group took a start in World championship.

National team consisting of 5 sportsmen took part in the international tournament on bullet shooting held in town Munich of Germany on January 21–26, 2014.

Our national team taking part at the international tournament on female wrestling held in Paris, the capital of France on February 07–11, 2014 won 2 gold medals.

National team consisting of 32 young sportsmen participated at international tournament on free-style and female wrestling held in Plovdiv town of Bulgaria on March 19–25, 2014. During the tournament our sportsmen won 3 gold, 1 silver and 1 bronze medal, but 1 gold, 1 silver and 5 bronze medal among the women.

National team consisting of 26 sportsmen participated at European championship on free-style and female wrestling held in Vantaa town of Finland on March 30 – April 05, 2014. Our sportsmen owed 3 gold, 3 silver and 4 bronze medals in the championship [6].

The members of the national team participating in Europe Cup among the youth on judo held in Greece on April 05–06, 2014 won 1 gold, 2 silver and 2 bronze medals.

The members of our national team Elmar Gasimov took II place, but Ilgar Mushkiyev took the III place at the European championship on judo among the adults held in Montpellier of France on April 24–25, 2014.

The President of Azerbaijan Republic signed a decree on successful participation of “Garabakh” football club on 17th December, 2014.

In order to widen and develop the international relations in youth and sport spheres the work with UNO, European Council, SRO, CIS and other international organizations and state organs engaged in youth and sport policy of separate countries have been continued.

The project of agreement was prepared aiming to strengthen agree mental legal base of the relationship with these countries and was agreed in a relative way. In the frame of these valid agreements different activities have been carried out. Representative delegation including youth and sportsmen leaving for foreign countries to take part at the international events was assisted in paper work necessary for their journey.

During independence period in general 50 Olympic Sport Complex were constructed in the towns and regions of our republic and put into service and 5 of such complex stipulated for the current year.

At present, the construction of Gymnastics Complex which will give an opportunity to hold the international contests according to the modern standards including I European Games to be held at high level in 2015; Re-



publican Sport Medical Center able to provide medical services to the sportsmen; Aquatic Sports Palace; construction works of Olympic Stadium accommodating 65 thousand of spectators; Trap and skeet shooting Sport Complex is continued to be newly constructed. Solid repairing works are carried out in Sport Concert Complex after Heydar Aliyev and Baku Sport Palace (Hand Games Palace). Project costs documents of European Games Park are prepared for construction of beach volleyball, beach football, water polo, 3x3 basketball sports, wreckage works are summed up in the area and preparation works for the construction have started [8].

We would like to remind that youth buildings are constructing and put into service according to "State Program of Azerbaijan Youth in 2011–2015". At the same time according to the program in current year 4 mini-football lawns in the districts have been put into service and appraisal of project costs of 16 different sport complex and construction-installation works are in the process of implementation.

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
